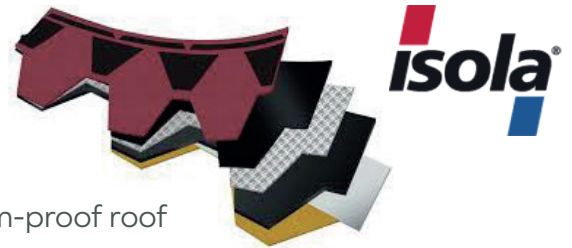

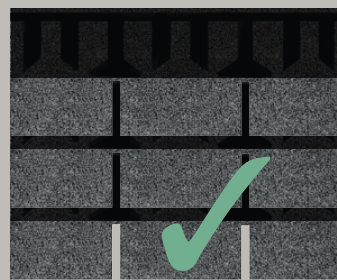

The shingles do not absorb moisture and remain unaffected by the wind and weather - year after year. Isola felt roofing shingles are coated with fine silan sand on the backside. Unlike normal sand it provides a barrier against humidity and prevents the ingress of moisture.

Tongue & groove guarantee a simple & correct horizontal laying

Connective adhesive area over the whole width of the shingle front & back, with unique adhesive for immediate bonding

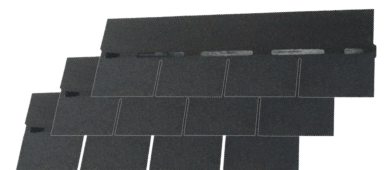
Defined nail points safeguard optimal attachment & sealing
